Re Joint Venture Tata Steel Europe - ThyssenKrupp

Dear Mr Chandrasekaran,

Allow me to introduce myself: I am the new Minister of Economic Affairs and Climate Policy in the government that took office in the Netherlands on 26 October.

I am responsible in this capacity for our country's industrial policy, and am therefore writing to you with some thoughts and questions about Tata's future in the Netherlands.

The Dutch government highly appreciates the close and pleasant cooperation with Tata Steel in the past years. Tata Steel Nederland is a very innovative industrial company and an important employer. Tata Steel Nederland therefore is a crucial part of our industrial structure.

The Dutch government understands the need for further consolidation in the global steel industry. We therefore see the agreement between Tata Steel Europe and ThyssenKrupp as an important step towards a steel industry that can meet the ever higher, challenging demands of car and other manufacturers and the construction industry. We welcome the Tata group's continued commitment to the Netherlands, and especially your decision to locate the headquarters of the proposed joint venture ThyssenKrupp Tata Steel in the Amsterdam region. We are also pleased that your research and development facilities will remain at the IJmuiden Technology Centre.

The constant technological innovation at the IJmuiden site is helping Tata Steel consolidate its long-term quality, profitability and sustainability. We see sustainable steelmaking as a crucial part of the Netherlands' industrial strategy for a sustainable economy. We therefore encourage plans for projects involving, for instance, the exchange of production gases as feedstock for the chemical industry, and carbon capture and storage. With breakthrough technology HIsarna, which dramatically enhances the iron making process, Tata Steel in IJmuiden is combining ground-breaking innovation with global relevance to meet the challenge of climate change – a combination that won you the Dutch government's enthusiastic support.

Both government and business will have to continue investing in developing a sustainable economy. I hope that Tata Sons will continue to support the

I can assure you that my Ministry's staff and the Netherlands Foreign Investment Agency stand ready to support Tata Steel throughout the process as the joint venture takes shape.
